WEIGHTED GRADES

Students who complete AP courses and take the national AP exam, receive an additional GPA point on the following scale: A=5.0; B=4.0; C=3.0; D=2.0. No additional points are given for grades of F.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The total number of credits required for graduation from SRCS is 250. Each course earns 5 credits per semester. The total 250 credits must include the following:
